<b>Name of the Scheme</b>	Mizoram IT Policy
<b>Description of the Scheme</b>	IT as the fastest and most advanced vehicle of change for all-round progress and development. In view of the potential of IT, state advocates widespread proliferation of IT and supports for promotion of IT in the fields of E-Governance, empowerment of the people and society, education, industry, health, rural development, agriculture, tourism, IT for masses, and IT enabled services.

<b>Nature &amp; Mode of Assistance</b>	<p>Fiscal incentives</p> <p>IT industry: IT industry shall cover development, production and services related to IT products, IT software, and IT services.</p> <p>IT products: 'IT products' include IT hardware including digital equipment and intermediate products thereof, specified telecom products, electronic components and IT software and related services.</p> <p>IT Software: IT software means any representation of instructions, data, sound or image, including source code and object code,</p>

recorded in a machine readable form, and capable of being manipulated or providing interactivity to a user, by means of an automatic data processing machine falling under the heading 'IT products' but does not include 'Non-IT products'. Term 'IT software' may be substituted in place of 'Computer software'.

IT services: It is defined as any service which results from the use of any 'IT software' over a system of 'IT products' for realising value addition.

IT enabled services: Any activity carried out based on the application of IT could be termed as IT enabled services. In other words IT enabled services cover the entire range of services which exploit information technology for empowering an organisation with the improved efficiency or a types of service which may not be possible to rendered cost effectively without IT.

New unit: New unit means IT unit which has commenced commercial production on or after the date on which the policy has been notified.

Existing unit: Existing unit means IT unit, which is or was in commercial operation at any time prior to the date on which the policy has been notified.

#### Registration

All IT industries are exempted from licensing registration for setting up of IT units. However, IT industries should be registered either in the form of Society or Co-Operative Society or Company for claiming of incentives.

IT units, which are export-oriented units, should obtain registration from Software Technology Park Authority. Separate incentives will be provided as per regulation laid down by GoI.

#### Exemptions of sales tax

IT industries shall be exempted from state sales tax for a period of 7 years from date of commencement of actual commercial production.

Exemption of central sales taxes and excise duties will be governed by various notification/orders issued by the GoI.

#### Power subsidy
